


Access and Parking

Booking an Appointment with us

Our practice operates on an appointment basis. Standard Consultations are approximately 15 minutes. If you need more time with your doctor, please arrange a long consultation when making your booking. We also offer an online booking system that can be accessed via our website or from your mobile device, and is available 24/7. You can download the "HotDoc App" for iPhone & Android from our website. Alternatively you are welcome to call our Reception Team on 08 8295 3200.

Consultations

Our appointment system caters for urgent, non-urgent, complex, planned chronic care and preventative healthcare. Emergencies will always be given priority and our reception team will attempt to contact you if there is any unforeseen events that may affect your appointment time.

Consultation Fees

HotDoc

We are a private billing practice and therefore you will need to pay your consultation fees on the day you attend our Practice. Consultation Fees not paid on the day may incur an additional charge.

Standard Consultation - \$ 93.20 (Adult) – Medicare Rebate \$ 38.20 **Long Consultation -** \$ 153.95 (Adult) – Medicare Rebate \$ 73.95

Department of Veteran Affairs Card Holders and Children 0 – 10 years old are Bulk Billed on week days, and we offer a reduced consultation gap for Aged Pensioners and children 11 - 16 years old. All new patient appointments are booked as a Long Consultation to allow the doctor to take a medical history as well as treat your current concerns.

Minor Procedures & Wound Management

When the doctor performs a minor procedure or post-procedure follow up you may incur a private facility fee to assist with the cost of surgical consumables such as wound dressings, suture materials and local anaesthetic. For further information please speak with our Practice Nurse.

Urgent Appointments

Urgent appointments will be seen by the next available GP. Please advise our Reception if you believe you require an urgent appointment. Emergency Home Visits and Nursing Home Visits may be available on request.

Telephone Interpreter and National Relay Services

If you or a family member require an interpreter, please advise our Reception Team when making your appointment. We use the Telephone Interpreter Service (TIS) 1300 131 450 for patients from non-English speaking backgrounds. We also use National Relay Service (NRS) for patients with a hearing impairment. We can organise an "over the phone" service or within 48 hours if an "onsite" service is required.



Prescriptions, Referrals & Forms

An appointment with a GP needs to be made for all scripts, referrals and forms unless you make a prior arrangement with your GP. A fee may be incurred for an out-of-consult service.

Telephone Policy

Most issues are best dealt with in consultation with Your GP. Please inform our Reception staff if your call is urgent. Your call will be transferred to one of our Practice Nurses to be triaged.

Investigations / Test Results

All results are reviewed by the treating GP. We ask that patients follow up results with a GP appointment.

Recalls & Reminders

We utilise an SMS service to advise you of the need to attend for a recurring test or a review appointment. These reminders may be for a Care Plan/Review, Immunisation, Cervical Screening Test or for Review of a Medical Condition.

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Patient Feedback

Occasionally we invite patients to complete questionnaires in relation to our practice and services, and how you think we can improve. These surveys are confidential and assist us to continually improve our practice.
